We will begin the Pilgrimage after breakfast. (A vehicle/vehicles will also be going, dependent on how many Parishioners will come). During this Pilgrimage, we will pray for Ukraine and for our personal healing and intentions. Everyone is welcome.

With May, the month of Mary upon us, consider a pilgrimage with Mary. She helps us with the journey to God. But why Mary, and why a pilgrimage?

We turn to Mary because, first, we can learn from her. She is the one who always loved God with an undivided heart. And what is a pilgrimage if not a concerted effort on our parts to unite our divided selves to God!

Through a pilgrimage, we allow Our Lady to help us – to protect us and to escort us to her divine Son, our Lord.

One essential component of a Pilgrimage is transformation. St. James the Apostle is the Catholic patron of pilgrims because he witnessed Christ's transfiguration. In doing so, he was transformed. On pilgrimage we encounter reality and ourselves transfigured by the divine presence.

Pilgrimages evoke our earthly journey towards heaven and are traditionally very special occasions for renewal in prayer." – (Catechism of the Catholic Church).
