**Hymn to the Mother of God:** The Angel cried out to the One full of Grace: O chaste Virgin, rejoice! And again I say, Rejoice! Your Son has risen from the tomb on the third day, and raised the dead. Let all people rejoice! Shine, shine, O new Jerusalem, for the glory of the Lord has risen upon you! Exult now and be glad, O Sion! And you, O chaste Mother of God, take delight in the resurrection of your Son.

**Communion Hymn:** Receive the Body of Christ;\* taste the fountain of immortality.\* Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise Him in the highest.\* Alleluia, alleluia,\* alleluia. (Psalm 148:1)

**In place of:** “Blessed is He...”(p.71); “We have seen the true light...”(p.73), “May our lips be filled...”(p.73); “Blessed be the name...” (p.77), “Glory be to the Father...”(p.77): we sing: Christ is risen from the dead, trampling death by death, and to those in the tombs giving life.

*After the Dismissal the Priest raises the Cross three times proclaiming:*

**CHRIST IS RISEN!**
